## *Hints & Tips:*

- This piece is also a jig, so it needs to be played in 3's such as 1-2-3, 1-2-3 etc.
- Make sure the F#'s on the D string are stretched, or close to the 3rd fingers.
- The C's on the A string should be played with the 2nd finger back, close to the 1st finger.
